#### Dear Turner:

Northwest is in a unique position to make important long term decisions about the Society's future. We are in a rental facility and have financial resources but are underused by our membership. We need to know what our members would like the society to be or to offer. Please complete the enclosed survey and return to any Board member or the Hall by September 1<sup>st</sup>. The survey offers multiple choices of possible Society futures and your role in those futures. Help plan "Northwest the Society." Be creative - feel free to add things in any areas. Be honest - we need to know what you really want and not what you think we want to hear. Practical isn't necessary at this point. Once we know if the membership wishes change of any kind, the next step would be feasibility and research teams to determine what would be possible.

We have an opportunity to make changes BUT we don't have to. Sticking with the status quo should be as much a decision as making a change. We have a lovely facility and a great gymnastics program and there would be nothing wrong with keeping what we have.

The lease on our Schiller Park location will expire December 31, 2018. At that point, our rent will be \$125,000 annually. We currently operate an outstanding gymnastics program, used by the children in the local area. We host six social events a year and hold five Society meetings at the hall. A small group of older male members use the hall weekly and the Ladies Auxiliary holds a monthly meeting. We offer hall rentals mainly for turner members and operate Texas Hold'em tournaments for fundraising purposes.

Our Head coach's contract will expire at the end of 2015. Yefim is beginning to look toward retirement but will work with us to meet our needs. Yefim's retirement will have a significant impact on the gymnastics program but, as we've seen in the past, the program will bounce back within a short time under a new coach. Transition planning is critical and we're grateful we'll have Yefim on board for this important management change.

The short list of choices would be to stay where and what we are; move somewhere else and/or make changes in our program and activities. Please give us your input in this important process.
